Dear Customer:

To protect our drinking water supply from harmful contaminants, Sarasota County Utilities, in cooperation with the State of Florida, has implemented a Cross-Connection Control Program. Established by Sarasota County Ordinance 89-19 and Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-555.360, the Sarasota County Cross-Connection Control Program establishes requirements to prevent cross connections within our customers' plumbing lines and to prevent backflow of contaminants from these lines into the county's drinking water distribution system.

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection requires our customers to comply with the ordinance by having an approved reduced pressure principle backflow prevention assembly installed on water service line(s) adjacent to the water meter(s) and tested annually.

Please contact a licensed plumbing contractor to install and test an approved reduced pressure principle assembly on your water service line. Your licensed contractor should mail the test results within 30 days of the installation, to Sarasota County Utilities, Attn. Douglas E. Bailey, 1001 Sarasota Center Blvd. 34240. You can also fax a copy to (941-861-0528). Please request a copy of the test results for your records.
