Swift Road sewer work will require lane shifts, road closures

From Oct. 12-16, traffic will be rerouted on Swift Road between Bee Ridge Road and Wilkinson Road while work continues on the Area N Phillippi Creek Septic System Replacement Program. The current configuration of two-way traffic on the northbound side of Swift Road will be switched to the southbound lanes on the morning of Oct. 12. This move will not allow a left-hand turn onto Bee Ridge Road for northbound traffic on Swift Road.

Work to install sewer pipes will also force the closure of the following roads along the east side of Swift Road; Sterling, Stoneland, Forest, Edgewood and Maiden lanes. Westbound traffic on these streets will be detoured to Bee Ridge Road. Detour signs will be posted.

Sterling and Stoneland Lanes will be closed for one week, Oct. 12-16, while Forest, Edgewood and Maiden lanes will be closed for two weeks, Oct. 12-23.

After the pipe installation, Swift Road will be resurfaced.

The speed limit in the area will be reduced from 40 mph to at least 30 mph, and to 20 mph in some areas.
