## Cleaning up the garage, lanai and more in Osprey

It's time to empty the closets and garage, clean off the lanai and gather up the stray brush that hasn't made it down to the curb for pick-up.

Sarasota County will hold its annual community cleanup day from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 13, for the Osprey community. Dumpsters will be provided by Waste Management and available at three locations to receive materials from residents.

The locations are:

- 300 N. Tamiami Trail (U.S. 41 and Church Street)
- Green Street and Glenwood Avenue
- West Oak Street (just east of Palmetto Avenue)

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste and other materials during this free event. Paint, pesticides, auto parts, televisions, computers and other hazardous materials cannot be accepted.

County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.
