Sarasota County will hold its annual community cleanup day from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday, March 1, for the Englewood community. Dumpsters will be provided by Waste Management and available at four locations to receive materials from residents.

The locations are:

- West Dearborn Street and McCall Road
- Green Street and Orange Street
- Michigan Avenue and Selma Avenue
- Michigan Avenue and East Langsner Street

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste and other materials during this free event. The Household Hazardous Waste Unit also will be present to accept household chemicals and electronics. Auto parts cannot be accepted.

County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.
