These durable windows will contribute to the integrity of the new two-story Family Service Center building, allowing vital social services to be provided uninterrupted in the event of a hurricane. The windows were Single Hung 700 Series with white frames and azure glass.

WinGuard windows combine heavy-duty aluminum with impact-resistant laminated glass. Upon impact from windborne debris or wind, laminated glass adheres to the interlayer, keeping the glass intact within the frame.

“PGT is proud to support North Port in its efforts to better the community,” says Rod Hershberger, CEO of PGT. “We are glad to lend a helping hand, knowing these positive changes will result in improving lives.”

The goal for the new building is to increase the number of citizens receiving and benefiting from the services offered at North Port's Family Service Center.
