Sections of five roads slated for resurfacing under economic stimulus program

A total of 17.2 lane miles of roadway are slated for resurfacing under a \$3.3 million contract awarded Tuesday by the Sarasota County Commission. The project will be funded largely by the penny surtax (1-cent sales tax) as part of the county's economic stimulus program of fast-track projects.

APAC-Southeast Inc. of Sarasota, the lowest of three bidders, was awarded the contract to resurface the following roads:

- Beneva Road from U.S. 41 to State Road 72 and from Proctor Road to Bee Ridge Road
- Bahia Vista Street from Tuttle Avenue to the Phillippi Creek Bridge
- Central Sarasota Parkway from McIntosh Road to Turtle Rock Boulevard
- Tuttle Avenue from Bee Ridge Road north through the traffic circle
- Beach Road from Midnight Pass Road to Ocean Boulevard

The work is expected to start Nov. 3 and be completed within 120 days, according to Sarasota County Project Manager Robbin Levar.

Residents and businesses will be notified via door hangers a few days before work begins on their street.
