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## **Fast-track resurfacing project to start Nov. 12**

Resurfacing sections of five roads – encompassing a total of 17.2 lane miles – will begin Wednesday, Nov. 12. The first roadway segment slated for resurfacing is Beach Road from Midnight Pass Road to Ocean Boulevard on Siesta Key.

The \$3.3 million resurfacing project will be funded largely by the penny surtax (1-cent sales tax) as part of the county's economic stimulus program of fast-track projects.

The contractor, APAC-Southeast Inc. of Sarasota, also will resurface the following road segments:

- Beneva Road from U.S. 41 to State Road 72 and from Proctor Road to Bee Ridge Road
- Bahia Vista Street from Tuttle Avenue to the Phillippi Creek Bridge
- Central Sarasota Parkway from McIntosh Road to Turtle Rock Boulevard
- Tuttle Avenue from Bee Ridge Road north through the traffic circle

Project completion is scheduled within 120 days, under terms of the contract awarded Oct. 28 by the Sarasota County Commission.

Residents and businesses will be notified via door hangers a few days before work begins on their street.
