Eastbound lanes of Clark Road rerouted due to water main break at Clark and Beneva Road intersection

Sarasota County Utilities is working with Florida Department of Transportation and local law enforcement to reroute traffic from all eastbound lanes of Clark Road at Beneva Road while repairs are made to a water main break. Traffic and Utilities officials expect the detour to last no longer than two days, and urge motorists to avoid this intersection while repairs are under way. During repairs, the eastbound lanes of Clark Road will narrow to two left turn lanes that will allow a northbound turn onto Beneva Road. Traffic going north on Beneva will be routed east onto Proctor Road, then south onto Sawyer Road and back onto Clark Road. Motorists can also turn south off of Clark onto Beneva, then east onto Palmer Ranch Boulevard, north onto McIntosh Road and back out to Clark Road.

The road is being closed to repair a 12-inch water main break that occurred in the center eastbound lane of Clark Road at Beneva Road Monday morning. It is affecting an estimated 13 businesses, but no residences at this point.

Further information, including whether a precautionary boil water advisory will issued, will be issued as soon as it becomes available.
