All-America City Quilt on display at Sarasota County Administration Center

The All-America City Quilt, which symbolizes outstanding civic spirit and features Sarasota County, is on display in the reception area at the Sarasota County Administration Center, 1660 Ringling Blvd., Sarasota. The quilt is touring All-America City finalist locations and will be in Sarasota County until Tuesday, Jan. 13.

Sarasota County won the designation in 2006 and was named a finalist in 2008 during the National Civic League Conference. Each of the 16 All-America City finalists in 2008 contributed hand-crafted, originally designed quilt squares that were sewn together to create this symbol of civic excellence.
