It's time to empty the closets and garage, clean off the lanai and gather up stray brush. Sarasota County will hold its annual community cleanup day from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 19, for the Laurel community.

Dumpsters provided by Waste Management will be available at three locations to receive materials from residents:

- Forest Street at Laurel Park
- Church Street at Johnson Chapel
- 504 Collins Street (across from the Sandra Sims Terry Recreation Center)

Residents can dispose of most appliances, household items, scrap materials, unbundled yard waste and other materials during this free event. Paint, pesticides, auto parts, televisions, computers and other hazardous materials cannot be accepted.

Sarasota County employees will be available at each site to offer assistance.
