## **West side of Bay Street will close Oct. 26 for up to two weeks**

The west side of Bay Street in Osprey will close to traffic for 10-14 days starting Monday, Oct. 26, while construction of the U.S. 41 Bay Street force main project is under way. The northbound and southbound turn lanes onto Bay Street from U.S. 41 also will be closed. The closing will not affect traffic turning onto the east side of Bay Street.

Northbound traffic will be rerouted to Holland Street, while southbound traffic will be detoured to Shumard Street. Detour signs will be posted and flagmen will be present.

The 16-inch-diameter Bay Street force main will be installed on Bay Street from U.S. 41 to The Legacy Trail. This force main is part of the system that will transmit wastewater from the U.S. 41 corridor to the Central County Water Reclamation Facility.
