‘Hope for Homeowners’ seminar on Nov. 30 offers free foreclosure information

Sarasota County homeowners who need help with foreclosures, bankruptcy or credit problems can attend a free “Hope for Homeowners” seminar from 6-7:30 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 30, at the Venice Library, 300 S. Nokomis Ave., Venice.

Chief Judge Lee Haworth will lead a panel discussion by financial and legal experts. He will explain what the courts are doing to protect homeowners facing foreclosure. Attorney Anne Weintraub will join the panel to explain the legal options that people have when they are threatened with foreclosure.
