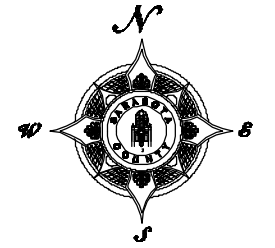


**FIGURE 5-1

ENVIRONMENT**

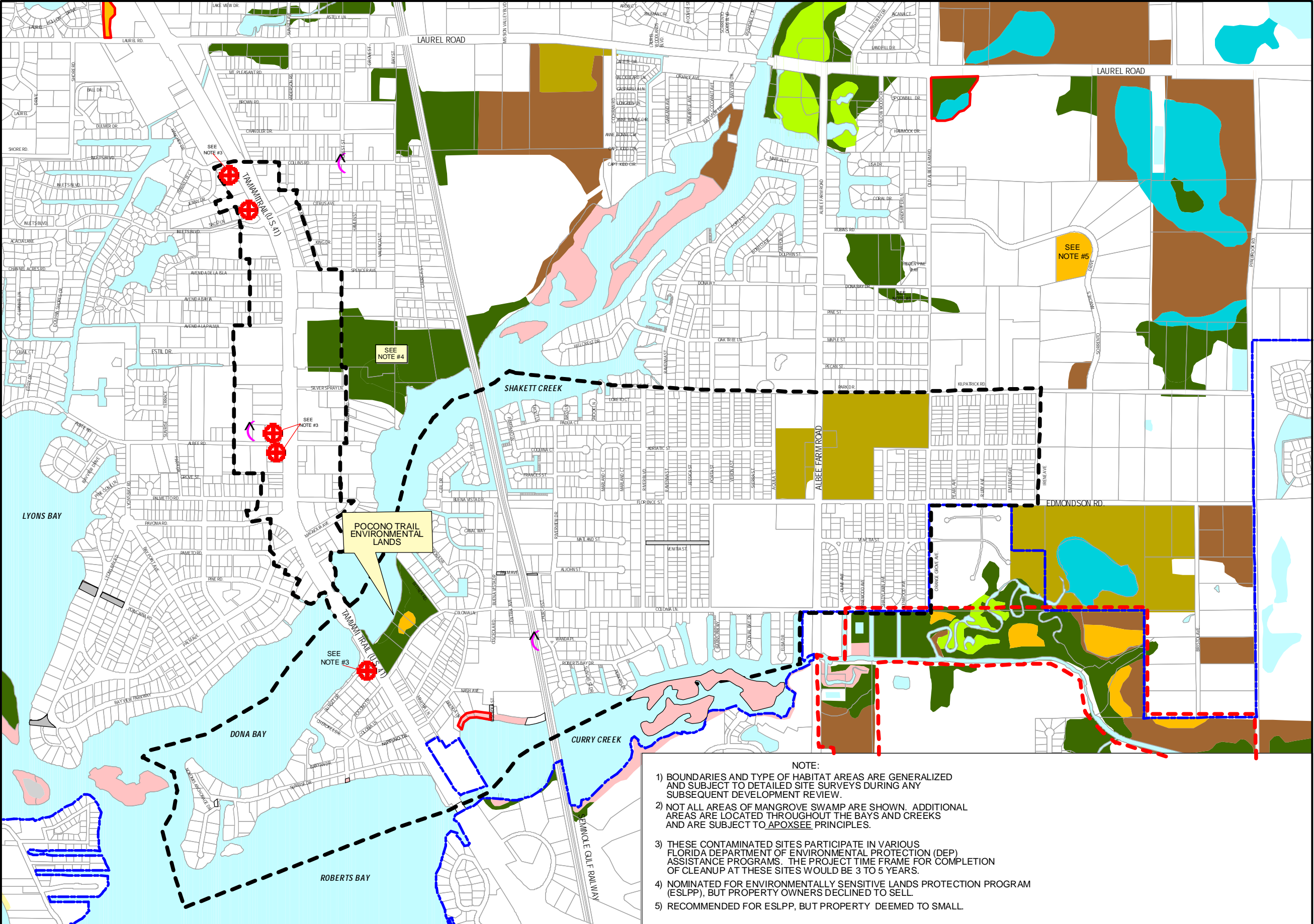

- 2) NOT ALL AREAS OF MANGROVE SWAMP ARE SHOWN. ADDITIONAL AREAS ARE LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE BAYS AND CREEKS AND ARE SUBJECT TO APOXSEE PRINCIPLES.
- 3) THESE CONTAMINATED SITES PARTICIPATE IN VARIOUS FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (DEP) ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS. THE PROJECT TIME FRAME FOR COMPLETION OF CLEANUP AT THESE SITES WOULD BE 3 TO 5 YEARS.
- 4) NOMINATED FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE LANDS PROTECTION PROGRAM (ESLPP), BUT PROPERTY OWNERS DECLINED TO SELL.
- 5) RECOMMENDED FOR ESLPP, BUT PROPERTY DEEMED TO SMALL.
