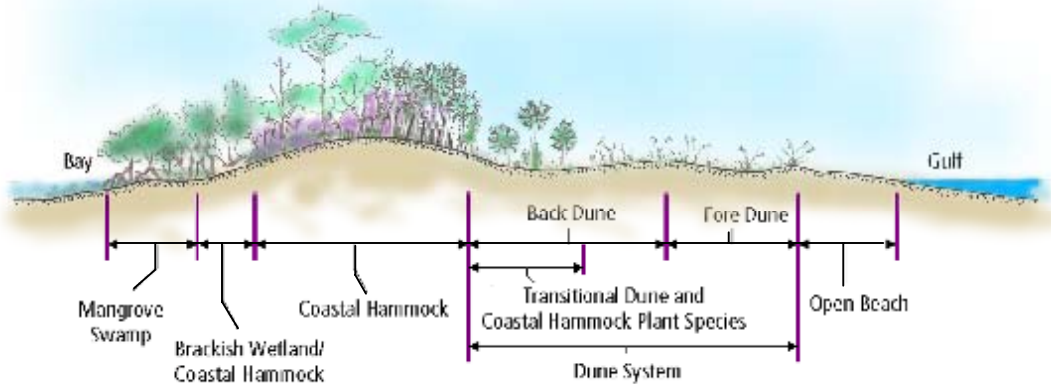


Coastal Hammock/Dune Habitat Plants Typically Found at Local Native Plant Nurseries
