**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA**

**RE: SARASOTA COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION GENERAL PRICING PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Section 90-34 of the Sarasota County Code (the "Code") authorizes Sarasota County Parks and Recreation to charge fees for specific parks and recreation services and to provide a general fee schedule to the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") for adoption by resolution with amendments from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 23, 2002, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2007-270, which established a parks and recreation fees schedule, which was subsequently amended by Resolution No. 2008-094 to reflect the current cost of providing parks and recreation services to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon staff research of best practices around the country and in Florida, relating to fees and charges for specialized parks and recreation services, it is a generally accepted practice that the General Manager/Director for a County parks program be authorized to establish fees for short-term promotional events and for seasonal park programs with a limited duration, i.e., summer camp programs, in order provide greater flexibility, affordability and marketing capability; and

**WHEREAS**, staff search has further indicated that it is necessary to amend the parks and recreation fee schedule and the services offered to reflect the current cost and the current level of services being offered in other Florida communities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Sarasota County, Florida, that:

1. The "Sarasota County Government Parks and Recreation General Pricing Plan", attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted as the Parks and Recreation fee schedule.
2. The General Manager of Parks and Recreation is authorized to establish fees on an annual basis for camp programs, special events, activities and programs of limited duration. The General Manager is further authorized to establish promotional rates and passes to encourage utilization of park facilities by targeted groups. All other fees shall be established by Board Resolution.
3. This Resolution shall take effect November 10, 2008, on which date Resolution No. 2008-094 shall be repealed

4. This Resolution shall remain in effect until further action by the Board.

## PRICING

### GENERAL INFORMATION

**Mission Statement: to partner with the community to provide exceptional beaches, parks and recreational programs that build strong healthy communities combined with economic and environmental sustainability.**

Parks and Recreation offers a wide variety of recreational opportunities. In order to ensure equitable use of our parks and facilities, there may be restrictions placed on the number of times a group is granted use.

The rental period charged to the permittee/user shall include the time needed for set-up and clean-up of their event or other use. The permittee or their designee shall be present for the duration of the rental period. Overage of allotted time shall result in additional room rental charges.

Section 90-34(a)(1)d of the Sarasota County Code of Ordinances provides that Parks and Recreation is authorized to charge user fees for the use of a facility, participation in an activity (e.g., summer camp programs, events, activities, campgrounds and facility programs) or fares for a controlled ride. All fees shall, to the extent practicable, be equal to the average cost, including overhead, incurred by Parks and Recreation in programming and maintenance for facilities under its control. Pricing and policies for these activities shall be established by the General Manager of Parks and Recreation. Rates and charges can be modified on a case-by-case basis by the General Manager of Parks and Recreation for special promotional opportunities designed to stimulate increased utilization of Parks and Recreation programs. Co-sponsorship opportunities are offered on a limited basis at the discretion of the General Manager of Parks and Recreation to non-profit organizations that align with the mission of Parks and Recreation. Parks and Recreation staff reserves the right to determine which organizations and events being held on park property align with the mission of Parks and Recreation. All catering services must be approved in writing by staff one week prior to any event being held on Park Property.

All Parks and Recreation Facilities (indoor space) will be closed Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Please contact specific Parks and Recreation facilities for additional holiday closures and operational hours.

### PRICING CATEGORIES

The fees assessed by Parks and Recreation are not based on the individual, group, and/or organization requesting the reservation/rental. The event or the purpose of the use shall determine the category. Pricing and fees shall be based upon the following categories:

#### Category 1

- Official Government use for meetings or training during regular business hours for Sarasota County, City of Venice, City of Sarasota, City of North Port and Town of Longboat Key (8:00AM to 5:00PM Monday – Friday)
- Public Meetings/Public Workshops for official government use at any time of day.

#### Category 2

- Any regularly occurring, recreational, instructional, or educational class or program where the public is invited to participate
- Community group meetings to which the community is invited such as neighborhood/homeowner's association meetings, community partner meetings or community recreation group meetings

#### Category 3

- Any special event, carnival, festival or entertainment type of event, meeting or social activity (parties, weddings, birthdays, retirements) that is not open to the public that is utilizing less than 2,000 square feet

- Private education groups
- Church or religious affiliated groups (Venice Community Center excluded)
- Non-profit Not-for-profit (501 (c) 3) groups having fundraising events that align with the mission of Parks and Recreation with proof of active non-profit status

#### Category 4

- Any type of use for business or for-profit endeavor to gain publicity, advertising, or monetary benefit in any degree
- Non-profit organizations renting facilities for private or non-fundraising related events
- Non-government events that are open to the public - Expos, home shows, tournaments, fundraising events that do not align with the mission of Parks and Recreation
- Business, non-profit and for-profit uses that do not support the mission of Parks and Recreation
- Large events, large parties, large weddings using over 2,000 square feet for private or public purpose
- Political related activities such as candidate rallies and fundraising events.

### **SALES TAX**

Applicable sales and use tax shall apply and must be added to the fees.

### **PAYMENTS\***

If the rental is less than \$250, the entire fee is due at the time the reservation is made.

If the rental is greater than \$250 and less than \$499, a \$100 Reservation Deposit is due at the time of the reservation. The balance is due no later than 60 days prior to the reservation date. If reservations are made within 60 days of the event, the total rental fee must be paid at the time the reservation is made..

If the rental fee is between \$500 and \$999, a \$200 Reservation Deposit is due at the time of the reservation. The balance is due no later than 60 days prior to the reservation date. If reservations are made within 60 days of the event, the total rental fee must be paid at the time the reservation is made...

If the rental is \$1,000 or more, a Reservation Deposit of 20% of the total rental fee or \$500 (whichever is greater) is due at the time the reservation is made. The balance is due no later than 60 days prior to the reservation date. If reservations are made within 60 days of the event, the total rental fee must be paid at the time the reservation is made.

Note: All Reservation Deposits indicated above are applied to the total rental fee.

### **SECURITY DEPOSITS\***

At the time of final payment of the rental fee, a refundable Security Deposit, equal to the Reservation Deposit, is due and payable. For rentals up to \$250.00, the security deposit shall be \$100.00. The user shall be responsible for all costs associated with damages to park facilities, equipment, furnishings and grounds. This deposit shall be refunded upon verification by Parks and Recreation staff that the facility or grounds or other rental area has been returned to a condition similar to that prior to use and that there has been full compliance with the agreement/permit authorizing the event. Should the facility, grounds, or other rental area not be returned to its condition prior to use by the user, the deposit will be applied to the actual cost of necessary custodial services, and/or personnel charges, materials and equipment required to complete repairs. The user shall further be responsible for any costs greater than the amount of the deposit. A violation of any rental condition, rule, regulation, or ordinance, or a material misrepresentation by an individual, a group, and/or organization shall result in forfeiture of the Security Deposit. Parks and Recreation staff reserve the right to not accept rental or programming requests from any individual, group or organization.

Note: Some damages may require that a contractor be hired to complete repairs (e.g. damage to the historic building)

\*Venice Community Center and Phillippi Estate Park have separate deposit procedures and requirements due to the nature of advanced reservations at these sites. Please see sections entitled "Venice Community Center" and Phillippi Estate Park", page 6 and page 10, respectively.

**CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS\***

Refund requests shall be made in writing and submitted to Parks and Recreation. There will be no refund granted for a cancellation/refund request that is received 60 days or less prior to the reservation date. Parks and Recreation may reschedule the reservation if adverse environmental conditions occur including local advisory for a tornado, hurricane watch or warning, imminent flood warning or red tide. There will be no refund granted in cases of inclement weather. Note: there are no refunds on passes.

Refunds shall be granted pursuant to the following time frames for facility rentals:

\*Please see sections entitled "Venice Community Center" and "Phillippi Estate Park" for their cancellation and refund procedures, page 6 and page 10, respectively.

\*Refunds for programs: Some programs may not allow refunds and may not allow refunds after a certain date. There is a \$25.00 administrative fee to refund programs where applicable. Programs whose total cost is less than \$25.00 will not be eligible for a refund. Parks and Recreation staff reserve the right to determine which programs will be eligible for refunds and up to what dates refunds will be accepted.

Venice Community Center Open Space

No open space (parking lot) rentals are permitted at Venice Community Center.

Venice Community Center Reservation Deposit

If the rental is less than \$250, the entire fee is due at the time the reservation is made.

If the rental is greater than \$250 and less than \$499, a \$100 Reservation Deposit is due at the time of the reservation. The balance is due no later than 120 days prior to the reservation date. If reservations are made within 60 days of the event, the total rental fee must be paid at the time the reservation is made.

If the rental fee is between \$500 and \$999, a \$200 Reservation Deposit is due at the time of the reservation. The balance is due no later than 120 days prior to the reservation date. If reservations are made within 60 days of the event, the total rental fee must be paid at the time the reservation is made...

A minimum of 20% of the rental fee is due at the time of the reservation, for reservations made more than 120 days prior to the event date for rentals \$1,000 or more. The remaining rental fee may be paid 120 days in advance of the event date. Reservations made within 120 days of the event must be paid in full at the time of the reservation.

Note: All Reservation Deposits indicated above are applied to the total rental fee.

Venice Community Center Security Deposit

The security deposit shall be equal to the reservation deposit. For rentals under \$250, the security deposit shall be \$100. The user shall be responsible for all costs associated with damages to park facilities, equipment, furnishings, and grounds. The damage deposit will be refunded upon verification by Parks and Recreation staff that the facility or grounds or other rental area has been returned to a condition similar to that prior to use and that there has been full compliance with the agreement/permit authorizing the event. Should the facility, grounds, or other rental area not be returned to its condition prior to use by the user, the deposit will be applied to the actual cost of necessary custodial services, and/or personnel charges (billed at overtime /time and a half (1.5)) materials, and equipment required to complete repairs. The user shall further be responsible for any costs above the amount of the deposit. A violation of any rental condition, rule, regulation, or ordinance, or a material misrepresentation by an individual, a group, and/or organization shall result in forfeiture of the deposit.

Cancellation/Changing of Dates/Changing of the Reservation

For rentals under \$1,000, cancellations and changes to the reservation are accepted 120 days prior to the event date. Refunds will be processed minus \$25 refund processing fee. Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to Parks and Recreation.

For rentals over \$1,000, cancellations and changes to the reservation are accepted 120 days prior to the event date. Refunds will be processed minus the designated reservation cancellation fee. Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing to Parks and Recreation.

Reservations cannot be changed within 120 days of the event date.

Reservations made or cancelled within 120 days of event will not be eligible for refund.

**PHILLIPPI ESTATE PARK**

Edson Keith Mansion

The Edson Keith Mansion is a significant community resource that is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Strict limitations are necessary to preserve and protect this historical resource. The Mansion is closed on Mondays.

Phillippi Gazebo

The pavilion at Phillippi Estate Park consists of three interconnected gazebos.

Phillippi Estate Park Open Space

There are protected areas within the Phillippi Estate Park grounds that are not part of the rental program. Any permittable park open space area beyond those specified below shall be charged pursuant to the Park Open Space fees in the General Pricing Plan, and the applicable Pricing Category.

Phillippi Estate Park Reservation Deposit

Sarasota County reserves the right to require a security deposit. Phillippi Estate Park has separate deposit procedures and requirements. The security deposit also secures the date for those reservations made up to one year in advance and is applied to the total amount due for the reservation. A minimum of 20% of the rental fee is due at the time of reservation for reservations made more than 120 days prior to the event date. The remaining rental fee may be paid 120 days in advance of the reservation date. Reservations made within 120 days of the event must be paid at the time the reservation is made.

Edson Keith Mansion Security Deposit

A \$750.00 Security Deposit is required for Edson Keith Mansion.

A \$250.00 Security Deposit is required for Open Space Rentals at Phillippi Estate Park.

A \$100.00 Security Deposit is required for Gazebo Rentals at Phillippi Estate Park.

The user shall be responsible for all costs associated with damages to park facilities, equipment, furnishings, and grounds. This deposit shall be refunded upon verification by Parks and Recreation staff that the facility or grounds or other rental area has been returned to a condition similar to that prior to the rental and that there has been full compliance with the agreement/permit authorizing the event. Should the facility, grounds, or other rental area not be returned to its condition prior to use by the user, the

deposit will be applied to the actual cost of necessary custodial services, and/or personnel charges, materials and equipment required to complete repairs. The user shall further be responsible for any costs above the amount of the deposit. A violation of any rental condition, rule, regulation, or ordinance, or a material misrepresentation by an individual, a group, and/or organization shall result in forfeiture of the deposit.

Cancellations for Edson Keith Mansion

Cancellations are accepted up to 120 days prior to the event date. Cancellations must be submitted in writing to Parks and Recreation via Phillippi Estate Park. A \$200.00 reservation cancellation fee shall be applied for Edson Keith Mansion rentals. Refunds will be processed promptly, less the \$200 reservation cancellation fee.

Reservations made, changed or cancelled within 120 days of event for Edson Keith Mansion and Open Space Rentals shall not be eligible for a refund.

Reservations made or cancelled within 60 days of the event for Gazebo rentals shall not be eligible for a refund.

A \$25.00 Administrative Fee shall be retained for Open Space and Gazebo rental cancellations up to 60 days prior to the event.

OUTDOOR USE PRICES

**SHELTER RENTAL PRICES**

The rental period for a shelter is a four (4) hour period; Rental prices are based on the location, day of the week and size of the shelters.
