Sarasota County resumes services

Sarasota County is resuming a number of services after Tropical Storm Fay:

- Solid Waste pickup will be on a delayed schedule this week. Waste will be collected on the day following the normally scheduled day. For example, pickups scheduled for Tuesday will take place on Wednesday, regular Wednesday pickups will take place on Thursday and so on.
- Moveable bridges are closed to boat traffic but will reopen when traffic gates are reinstalled after being removed for the storm.
- Sarasota County government offices, county courts, the cities of Sarasota, Venice, North Port and the town of Longboat Key offices will re-open Wednesday.
- SCAT will resume services at 2 p.m. and run on regular schedules for the remainder of the day with the exception of the Route 21 Englewood neighborhood service and Route 40 Webber Street from Sarasota to the SCAT administration office. Route 99 will end at the airport and will not extend into Manatee County.
- Sarasota County schools will be open Wednesday.
