AN ORDINANCE OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA (ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 193) AMENDING SARASOTA COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 75-38, CODIFIED AS APPENDIX A OF THE SARASOTA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, RELATING TO ZONING WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SARASOTA COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; AMENDING SECTION 19, PLANNING COMMISSION: ESTABLISHMENT, PROCEDURES, POWERS GENERALLY, AND POWERS ON SPECIAL EXCEPTIONS AND SITE DEVELOPMENT PLANS, RELATING TO QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR EFFECT ON OTHER ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODING OF AMENDMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. **Findings.** The Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the "Board," hereby makes the following findings:

A. The Board has held public hearings on the proposed amendment described herein in accordance with the requirements of Sarasota County Ordinance No. 75-38 and has considered the information received at said public hearings.

B. The Board has received and considered the report of the Sarasota County Planning Commission regarding the proposed amendments provided herein.

C. The Board, sitting as the Sarasota County Land Development Regulation Commission, has reviewed the proposed amendments provided herein and has found that the amendments are consistent with the Sarasota County Comprehensive Plan.

Section 2. **Amendment to Section 19 of Ordinance No. 75-38, codified as Appendix A of the Sarasota County Code of Ordinances, relating to Planning Commission: Establishment, Procedures, Powers Generally, And Powers on Special Exceptions And Site Development Plans. Section 19.2. of Sarasota County Ordinance No. 75-38, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:**

2. **QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS.** No member of the Planning Commission shall hold any elective office of or be employed by any municipality or county government in Sarasota County. Members of the Planning Commission appointed after the effective date of these regulations shall be residents of the County for at least ~~five (5)~~ two (2) years prior to the date of appointment. Members shall be appointed based on the Board's determination of the type of skills, education or experience best suited to achieve the duties of the Planning Commission as set forth herein.

Section 3. Effect on Other Ordinances. The provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail in the event of conflict with the provisions of any existing ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be so construed as to render invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Coding of Amendments. In this Ordinance, language added to an existing Ordinance is underscored and language deleted is typed in ~~strike-through~~ type.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of the State of Florida.
