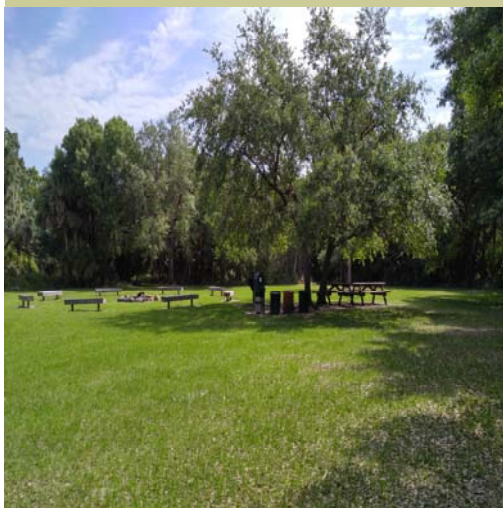

Primitive Camping:

The park offers primitive tent camping in an open grassy area surrounded by a shady oak and palm hammock.

Reservations and camping permits are required.

Fees: Adults \$5 per person per night with a \$10 minimum. Organized Youth Groups and children 17 and under are \$2 per person per night. Campsite capacity is 30 people.



Reservations can be made for individual or group tent camping. Check-in is available after 3 p.m. Check-out no later than 1 p.m. on day of check-out.

Amenities

Myakkahatchee Creek Environmental Park campsite amenities include a fire ring, a barbeque grill, and picnic tables. Parking is only allowed in the designated site marked as Campsite Parking. No vehicles are allowed around the immediate campsite. A restroom is located within 100 yards of campsite. Other park amenities include multi-use trails, scenic overlooks/boardwalks, a picnic shelter and barbeque grills.

Experiences

The natural beauty of this 162-acre park speaks for itself. The multi-use trails are available to equestrians, bicyclists and pedestrians; please use trail etiquette. As you explore the trails experience a piece of Old Florida; winding, wooded trails weave through a moss-draped oak canopy, while the trickling Myakkahatchee Creek flows nearby. See a variety of native flowers and trees, including live oak, blue flag iris, tickseed and swamp lily. Wildlife abounds, with alligator, deer, wild hogs, barred owl, herons and egrets calling this land home. The park has several boardwalks offering great vantage points for observation and contemplation.

Leave No Trace philosophy is required at campsite and throughout park.
