



















In December 2015, the U.S. Census Bureau released its 2010-2014 5-year estimates of the American Community Survey (ACS). These estimates compile surveys of residents in a geographic area over a period of five years. This release marks the first time that two 5-year estimates can be compared without overlapping years.
