

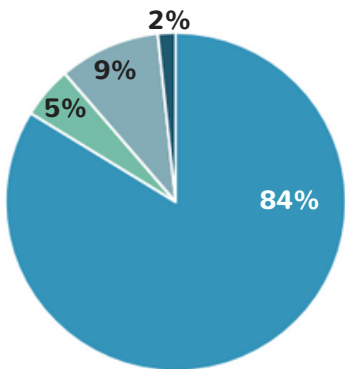
# SARASOTA COUNTY'S YOUTH



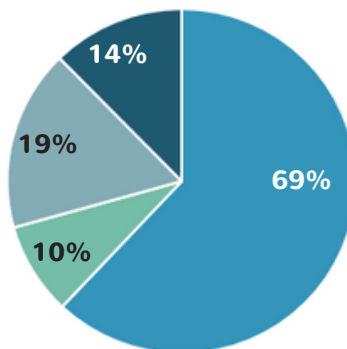

**Racial Diversity** is greater among the youth than the total population ...and is projected to increase.

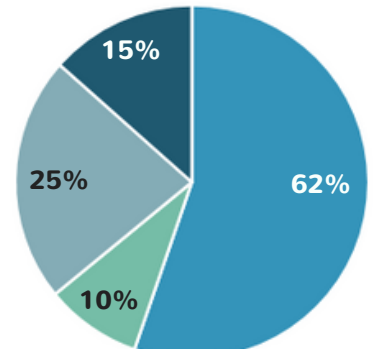
2016 Total Population<sup>(2)</sup>



2016 Under 18<sup>(2)</sup>

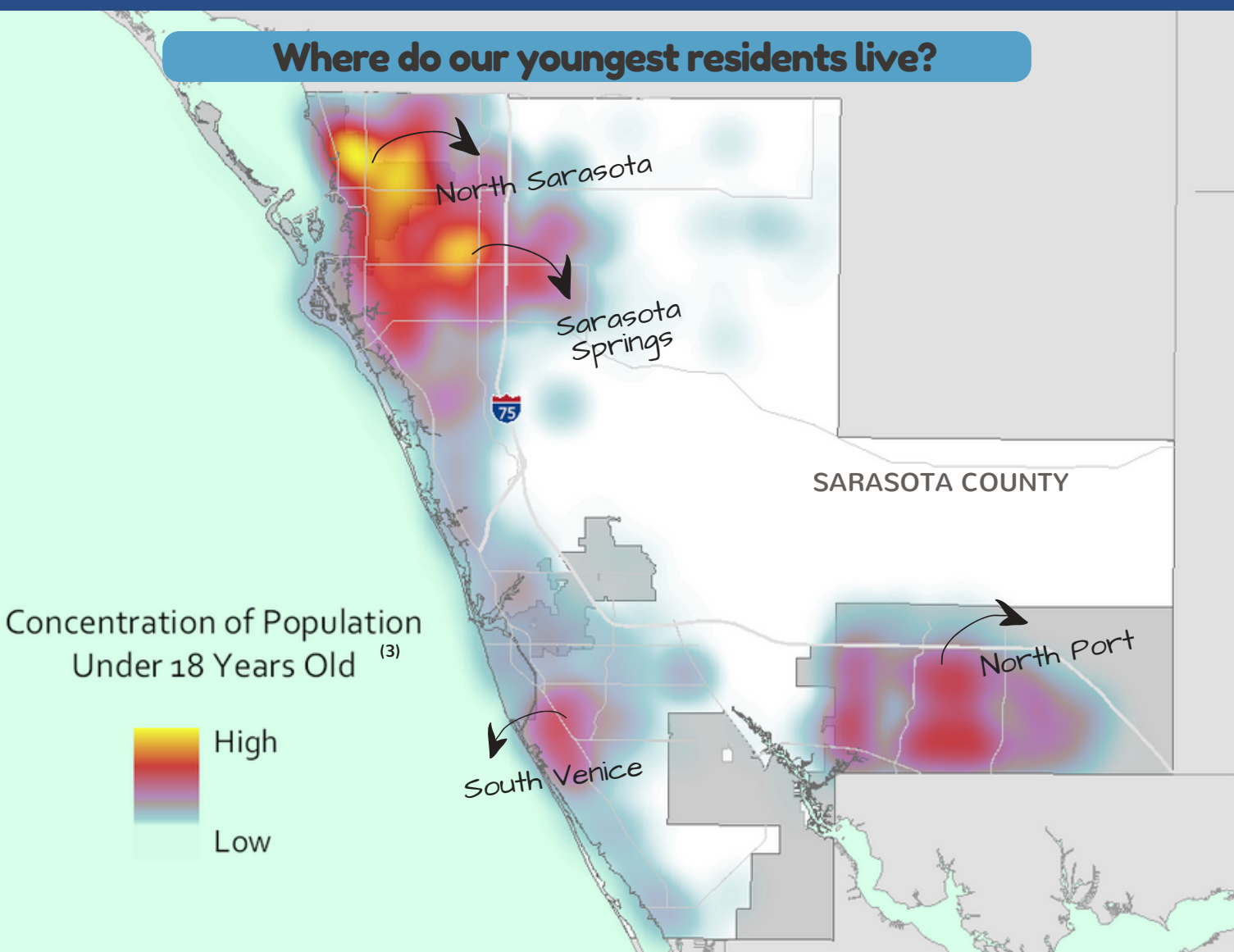


2045 Under 18<sup>(2)</sup>

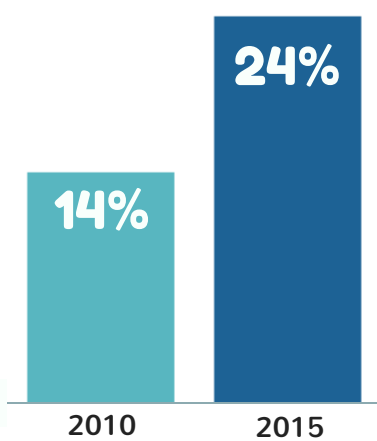

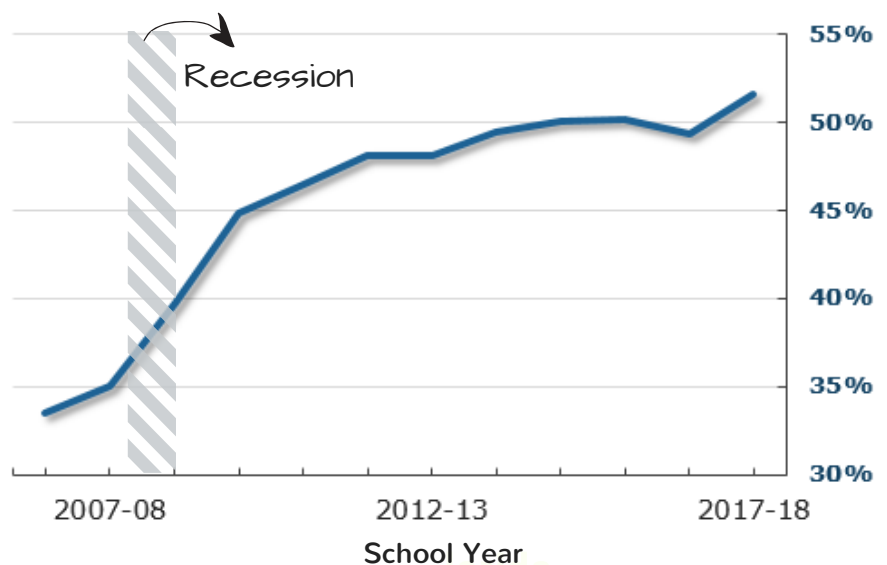
## Where do our youngest residents live?

## Births

In 2016, Sarasota Memorial Hospital delivered **3,559** babies. **HALF** were **Medicaid** cases.<sup>(6)</sup>
