RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA

RE: SARASOTA COUNTY POST-DISASTER REDEVELOPMENT PLAN (PDRP)

WHEREAS, Sarasota County is subject to natural and man-made disasters of such scale, so as to adversely impact life, property, natural resources, and the local economy; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes (F.S.), requires that each general purpose local government with jurisdiction over coastal lands include a coastal management element include a coastal management element in its comprehensive plan based on studies, surveys, and data (§163.3177(6)(g), F.S.); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes (F.S.), further requires that the coastal element contain a redevelopment component outlining the principles to be used to eliminate inappropriate and unsafe development in the coastal areas when opportunities arise (§163.3178(2)(f), F.S.); and

WHEREAS, the Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan fulfills the requirements of Chapter 163, Part II, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and the obligation to create a recovery plan in accordance with Sarasota County Comprehensive Plan ENV Policy 5.1.2; and

WHEREAS, a Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan is intended to function in concert with the Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) per Resolution No. 2010-207; and

WHEREAS, a Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan is intended to function in concert with the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) per Resolution No. 2009-127; and

WHEREAS, a Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan provides guidance for community redevelopment following a disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan identifies policies, operation strategies and decisions that affect long-term recovery and redevelopment after a disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan will be implemented administratively through the action plan appended to the primary PDRP document. Public hearings by the Sarasota County Commission may be necessary for supporting resolutions or ordinances; and

WHEREAS, The Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan applies to unincorporated Sarasota County; and

WHEREAS, the incorporated jurisdictions of the City of Sarasota, the City of North Port, the City of Venice, and the Town of Longboat Key are encouraged to participate in the

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implementation of the Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan through the local adoption of annexes to the plan and implementation of action plan items. Such annexes will be enabled as determined by the municipalities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARASOTA COUNTY FLORIDA in a public meeting assembled, that:

Section 1. The Sarasota County Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan is hereby adopted.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
