

Electronics, Monitors and TV Disposal

General Information

Sarasota County residents may bring the following types of electronics for complimentary drop-off at one of the Chemical Collection Centers.

- Computer Systems
- Fax Machines
- Keyboards
- Power Supplies
- Printers and Scanners

TVs and monitors are no longer accepted for disposal at the Chemical Collection Centers. They should be placed at the curb for pickup during regular weekly collection services.

Helpful Tips:

- If TVs weigh more than 40 lbs., contact Waste Management at 941-493-4100 to schedule a pickup. Requests should be made at least 48 hours in advance.
- TVs and monitors may be disposed of at the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (charges apply).
- Residents of multi-family complexes that use commercial dumpsters are required to call Waste Management to pick up TVs and monitors. These items may NOT be placed in commercial dumpsters.
- Businesses may bring eligible electronics, including TVs and monitors, to the Bee Ridge Chemical Collection Center or the Citizen's Convenience Center to be collected as part of Project Green Sweep (charges apply).
- Residents in the cities of Sarasota, Venice, North Port, and the Town of Longboat Key should contact their service provider for assistance.
