

# Items that **DO NOT BELONG** in your recycling containers.



## **NO Non-Recyclable Plastic**

### **NO plástica no reciclable**

Not everything that is plastic is recyclable!



## **NO Recyclables in Plastic Bags**

### **NO meten cosas reciclables en bolsas plásticas**

Empty loose recyclables in container.



## **NO Food and Liquids**

### **NO comida ni líquidos**

Compost if possible, or throw in the trash.



## **NO Paper Napkins, Plates, Cups and Tissues**

### **NO servilletas, platos o vasos de papel**

Compost if possible, and remember to recycle the cardboard tube from paper towels and toilet paper.



## **NO Polystyrene Foam**

### **NO espuma de poliestireno**

Foam, egg cartons and plastic to-go containers are not recyclable curbside. Foam packing peanuts can usually be returned to a shipping store.



## **NO Yard Waste**

### **NO desechos del jardín (ramas, grama u hojas) ni madera**

Compost or put in your yard waste container.



## **NO Electronics and Small Appliances**

### **NO cosas electrónicas ni electrodomésticos pequeños**

Donate if in good condition. Non-working items belong in the trash.



## **NO Hoses, Holiday Lights, Hangers and Extension Cords**

### **NO mangueras, luces de navidad, perchas y alargadores**

They wrap around equipment and can shut down an entire facility! They all go in the trash.



## **NO Plastic Bags, Film/Sheeting and Flexible Film Packaging**

### **NO bolsas plásticas o plástico adherente**

Take clean and dry plastic bags back to a local grocer to recycle.



## **NO Textiles, Bedding, Rugs and Carpet**

### **NO textiles, ropa de cama u alfombras**

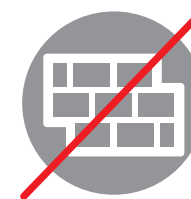
Donate these items if they are in good condition otherwise, they belong in the trash.



## **NO Auto Parts and Scrap Metal**

### **NO repuestos del auto o chatarra de metal**

Contact local scrap recyclers for recycling options.



## **NO Concrete, Wood and Construction Debris**
