**Screening Measures at County Facilities Due to COVID-19 Health Emergency
and Alternative Options for Providing Public Comment**

Consistent with the guidance from CDC and the Executive Orders of the Governor of the State of Florida to limit public interactions, the public is strongly encouraged to submit any comments on matters to be addressed by the Board of County Commissioners in advance of the Commission meeting to be included in the official meeting record. Visit www.scgov.net/publicinput to access the online public comment form. If you do not have internet access, please call (941) 861-5000 for assistance.

In light of the extraordinary circumstances surrounding the COVID-19 Health Emergency and to protect the health and safety of our staff and the general public, health screening procedures are in effect for visitors to County facilities, including Commission meeting attendees.

At the building entrance, the Screening Officer will ask each visitor the following questions:

1. **Have you traveled outside the state of Florida in the last 3 weeks or have you been in contact with anyone who has returned from travel outside the state of Florida within the last 3 weeks?** If yes:
 - a. Were you on a cruise?
 - b. Were you outside the continental U.S. (including Alaska/Hawaii)?
 - c. Have you traveled by plane to or had a layover in the following states - California, Washington, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Louisiana?
2. **Have you had contact with someone who has, or is under investigation for, COVID-19?**
3. **Have you experienced signs or symptoms of a respiratory infection such as: Fever, cough, or shortness of breath in the last 14 days?**

If the visitor answers “**Yes**” to **ANY** question (1.a., 1.b., 1.c, 2. or 3.), entry will be denied. They may still provide public comment using the online form or phone options described above.
