Lighting				
Consider using ENERGY STAR labeled light emitting diodes (LED) bulbs. Be sure to research which applications make the most sense in your home.				
Replace inefficient ceiling or wall mounted light fixtures with ENERGY STAR qualified fixtures.				
Seal the Leaks				
Add adequate attic insulation. (Go to www.energyupgradetoday.com for incentives)		\$49.03

Make sure your roof is properly vented. A roofing contractor can assist you with this.				
Den or Media Room				
When buying new electronics look for the ENERGY STAR label.				
Laundry Room

Look for the ENERGY STAR label when replacing a kitchen range hood.		\$3.00		
Heating and Cooling				
Shade east, west and south sides of your home by adding trees or awnings.				
Add window film to block out the solar heat gain.				
Electronics				
When replacing a cordless phone look for the ENERGY STAR label.				
Moisture Prevention				
If you need a dehumidifier look for the ENERGY STAR label.		\$18.00
