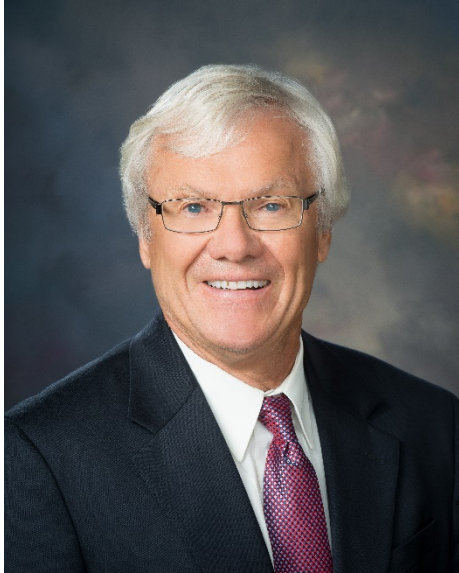


# WATER QUALITY SUMMIT
