Tricia Hobson is an environmental specialist with the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Office of Agricultural Water Policy, located in Sarasota. She joined the department in 2014 and works with the commercial agriculture community in implementing Best Management Practices (BMPs), which are developed to address nutrient management, irrigation management and water resource protection. In addition to working with agricultural producers to identify and implement BMPs, she also assists producers in cost sharing opportunities through the department, as well as coordinating with the Southwest Florida Water Management District's Facilitating Agricultural Resource Management Systems (FARMS) program and Natural Resources Conservation Service to fund the installation of BMP technologies and equipment to enhance water conservation and nutrient reductions. Prior to working at the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, she worked at Cardno (fka Entrix and Biological Research Associates), the Southwest Florida Water Management District and the U.S. Forest Service. She received her bachelor's degree in forest resources and conservation from the University of Florida in 1979.
