<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must arrive in a personal vehicle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Air conditioning must work - All people must be seated next to operating window • Items to bring: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Photo ID (Please place on the dashboard) - Health insurance card (everyone will be tested regardless if they have insurance) - Healthcare facility employee or first responder ID/Badge (if applicable) 	<p>THINGS TO CONSIDER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There are no bathrooms; • Each person who needs testing must be seated next to a working window; • All passengers must stay inside vehicles from arrival to departure; • Try to limit the people in your vehicle to those needing testing (maximum - 5 people); • There is no food bank distribution at this location; and • There may be significant wait times.
<p>ARRIVAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each vehicle will be greeted and directed by personnel in full medical protective gear. <p>TEMPERATURE CHECK</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your temperature will be checked using a no touch thermometer. <p>REGISTRATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each person who meets site testing criteria will be asked to provide the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Photo ID - Current address (where you are staying) - First and last name - Best phone number to reach you (indicate mobile/landline) - Healthcare facility employee or first responder ID/badge (if applicable) - Health insurance card (if available) <p>TESTING</p> <p>A healthcare provider in personal protective equipment will provide you with instructions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will be given a tissue to blow your nose and will need to keep your tissue to dispose on your own. • A soft swab will be inserted deep into your nose to get the necessary sample. This may be slightly uncomfortable; however, the test is quick and should take less than a minute. <p>INFORMATION & DEPARTURE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Once the test is complete, you will move to the final station. • You will be given information to take with you on what to do while awaiting test results. Please keep the instruction sheet until you get your test results. • Depart/exit Community-based Testing Site. • Follow the instructions on the paper provided by the Community-based Testing Site. Continue to monitor and record symptoms. You will receive test results via telephone call.
