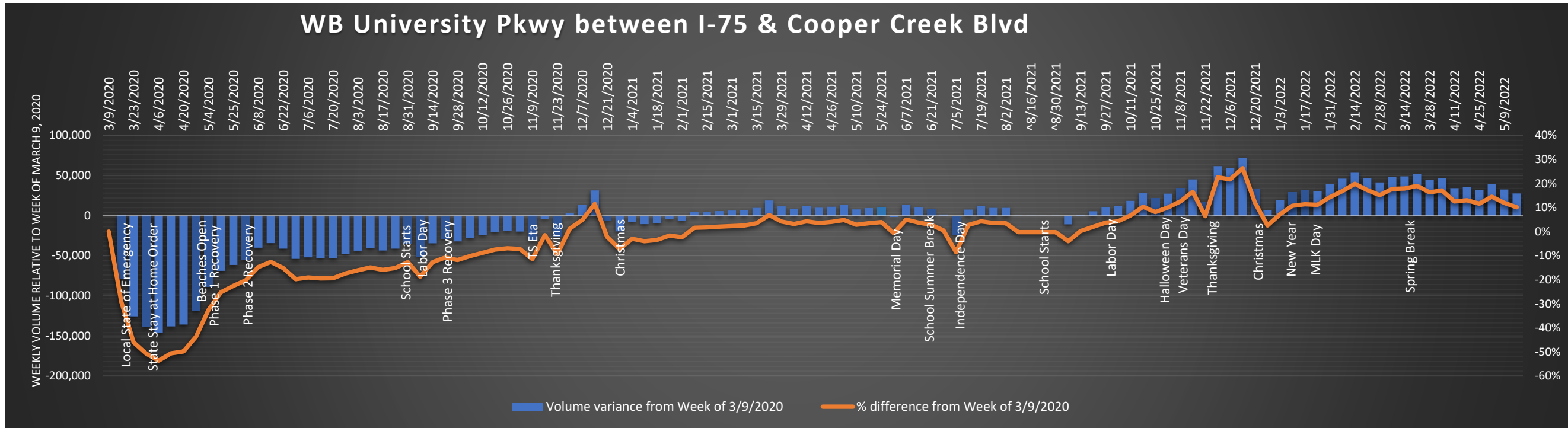

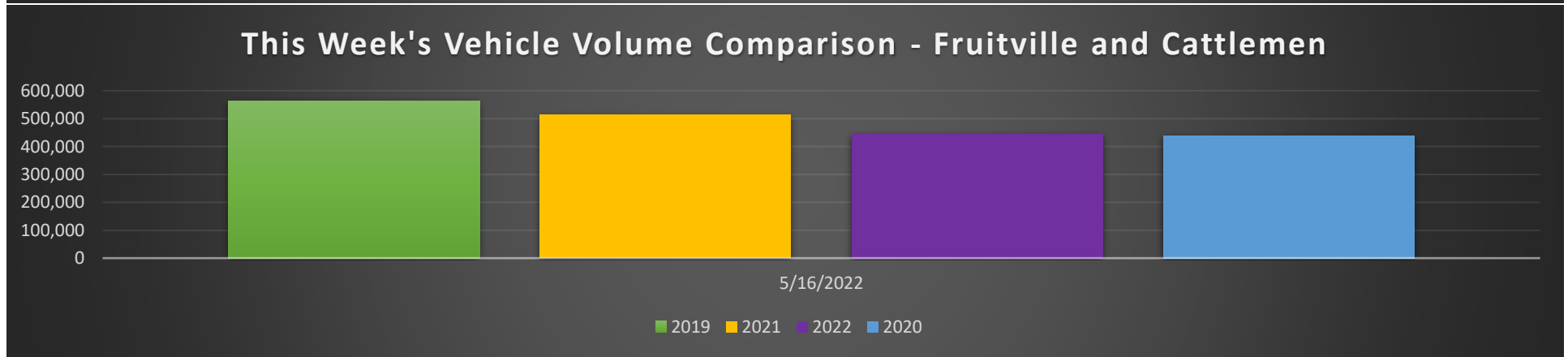
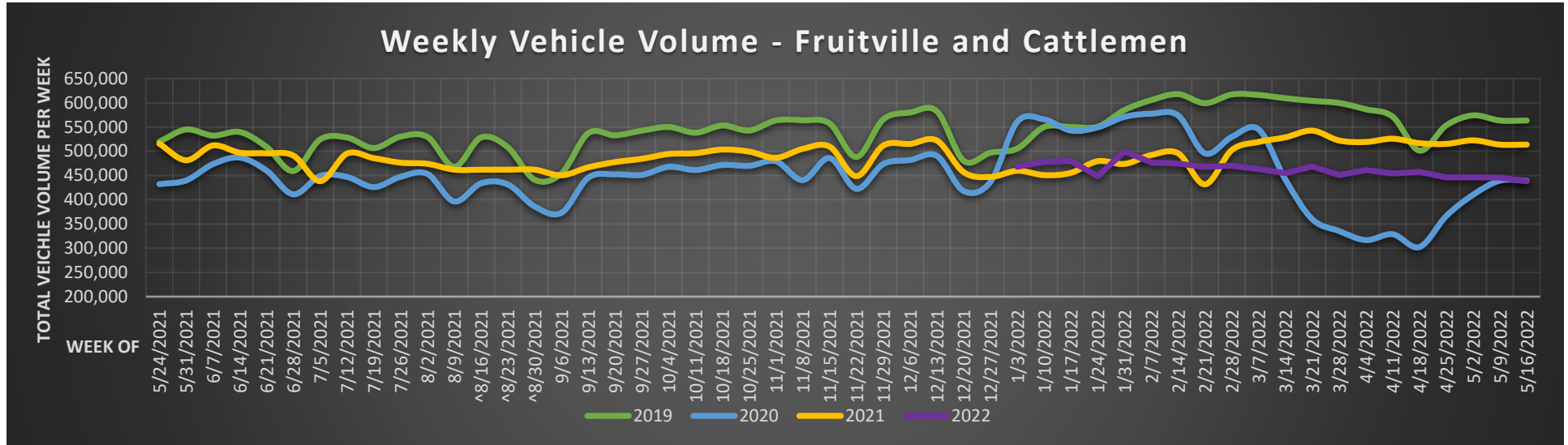
Weekly Change in Vehicle Volume Relative to a Baseline of the Week of March 9, 2020

WB University Pkwy between I-75 & Cooper Creek Blvd



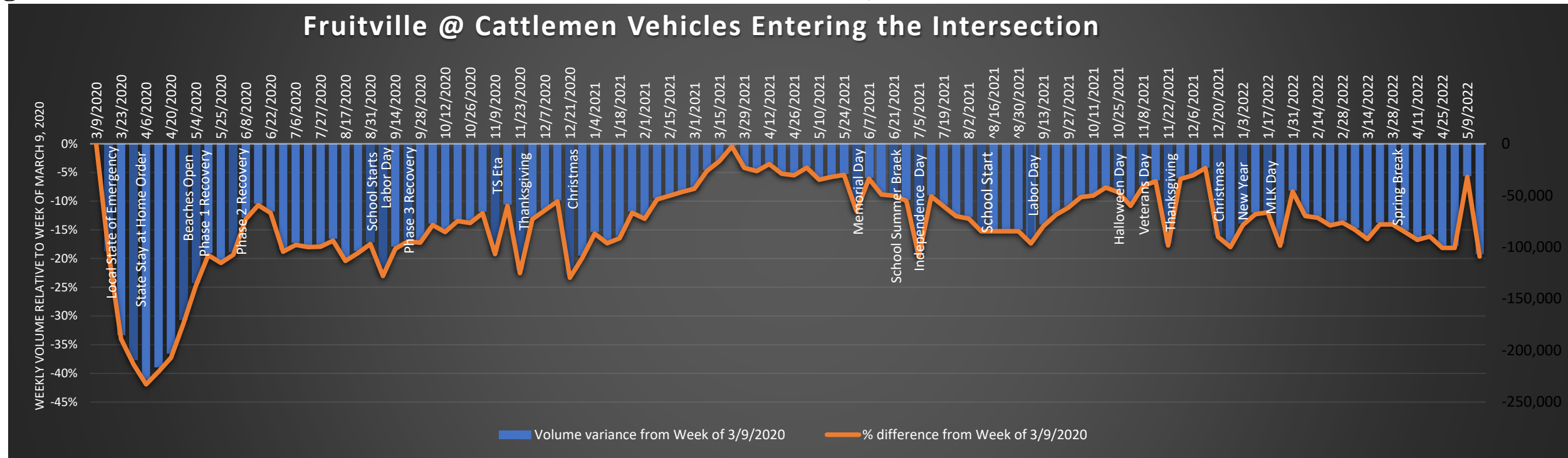

Sarasota County Vehicle Count per Week Compared to Previous Year



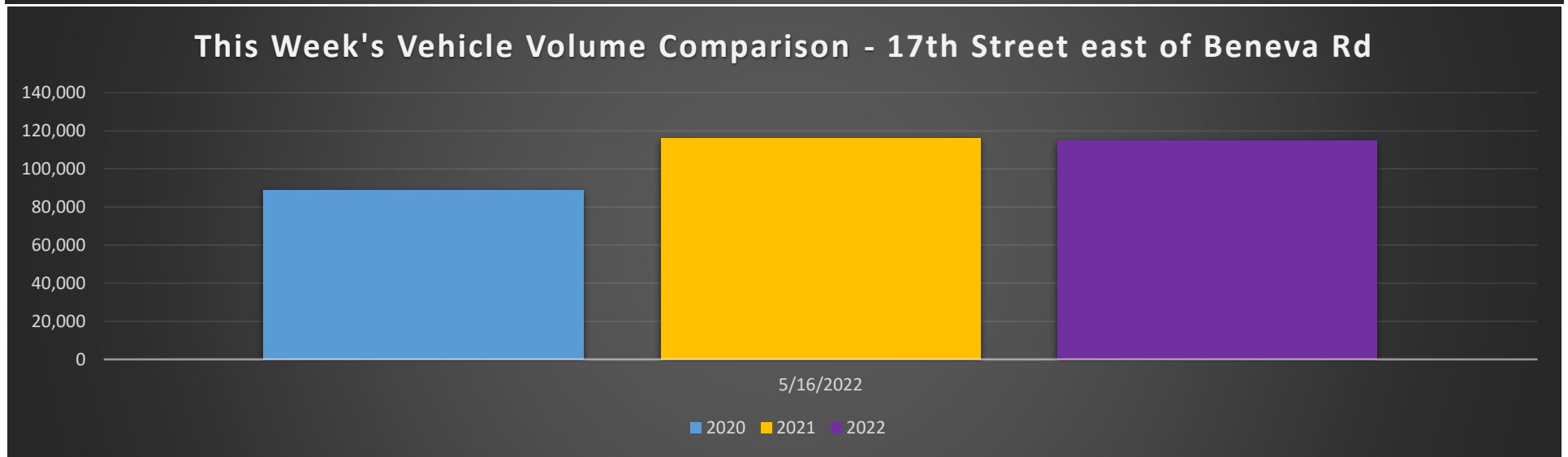
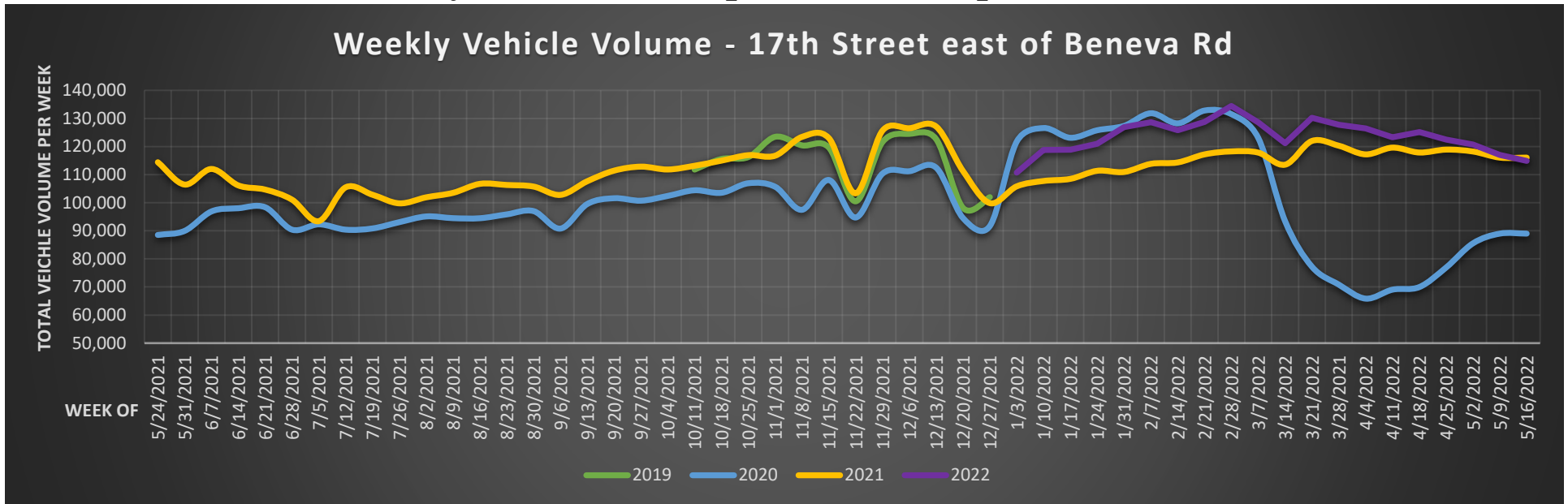

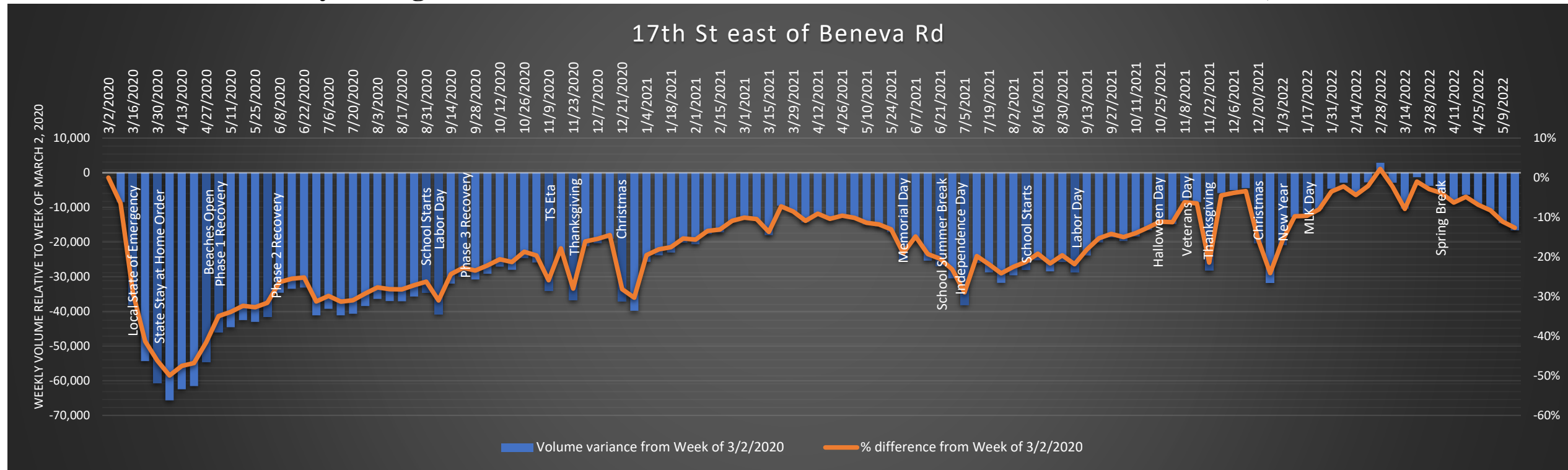

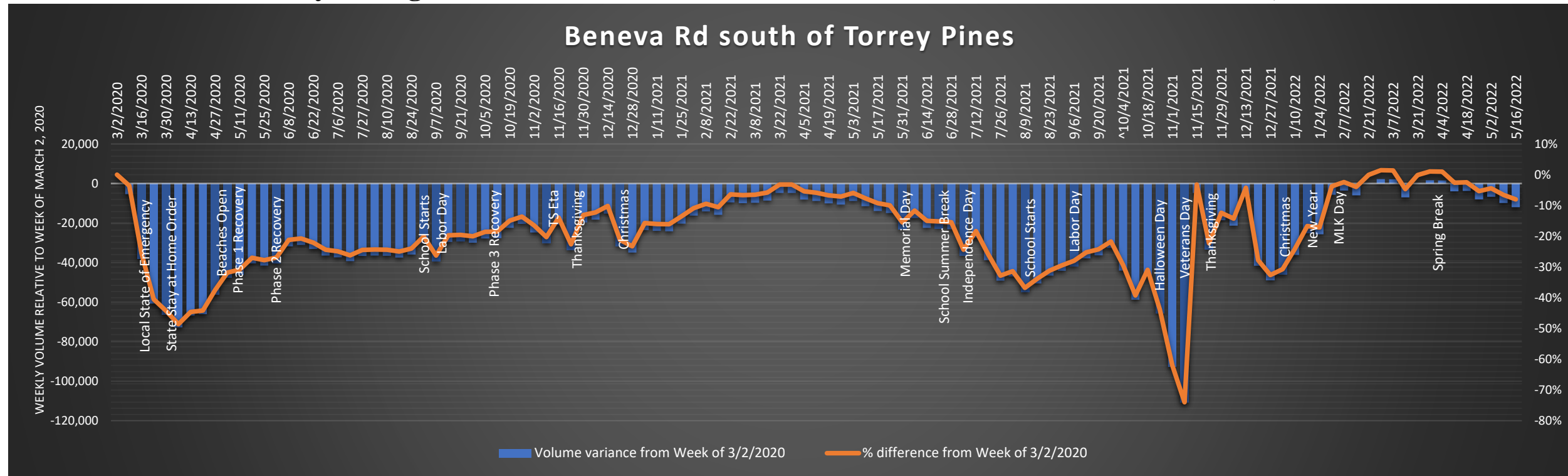

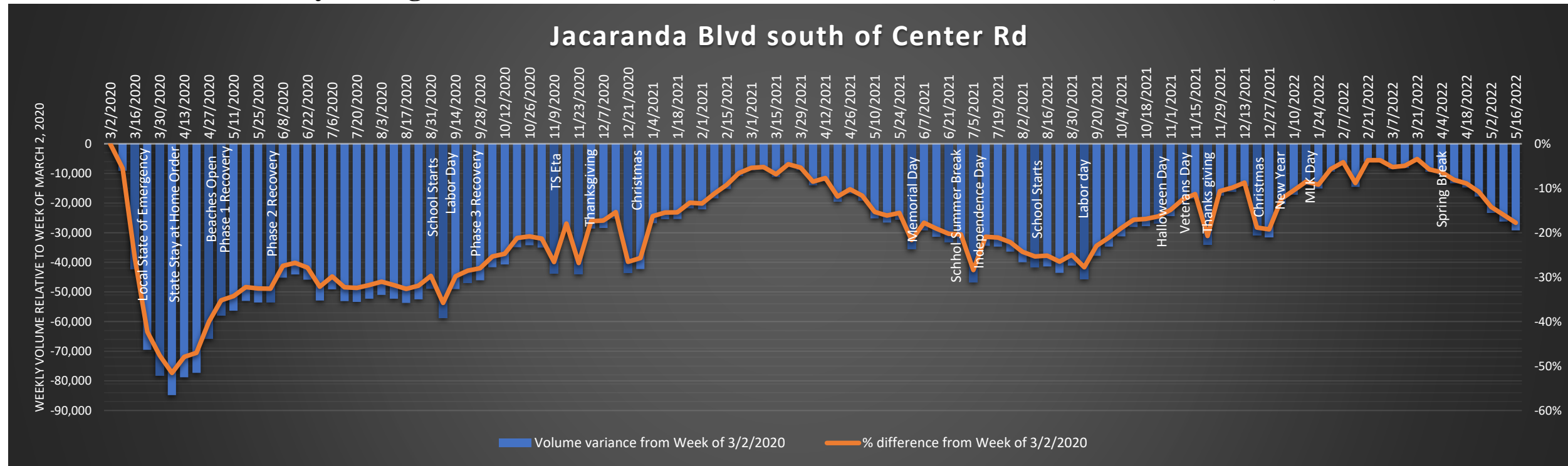
Sarasota County Vehicle Count per Week Compared to Previous Years

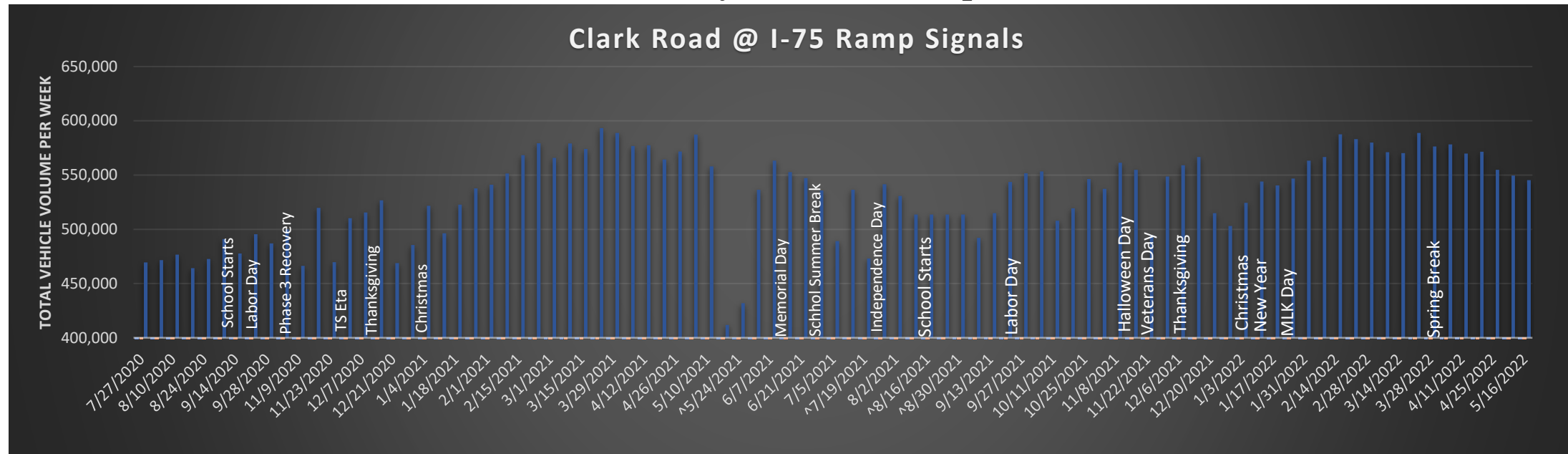
