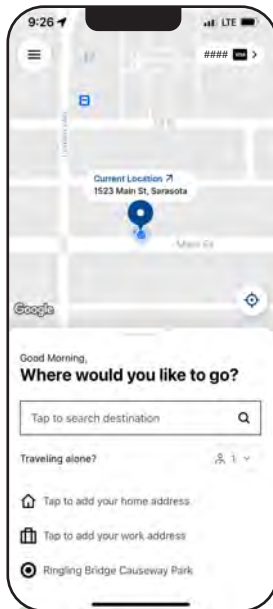

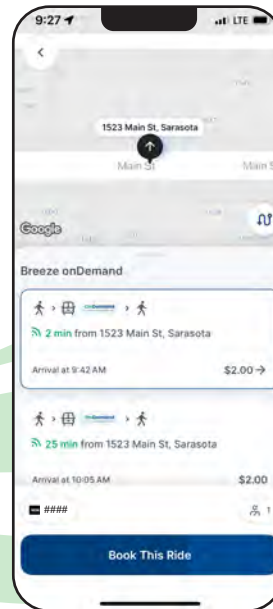

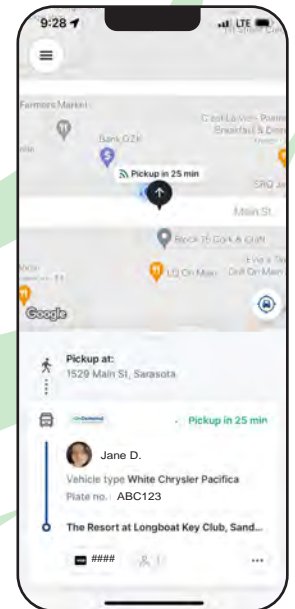

Frequently Asked Questions

What does a “shared ride” mean?

Other passengers may be picked up or dropped off at their requested locations during your trip. This is not considered a “companion passenger.”

Does Breeze OnDemand accept credit cards?

Credit cards can be used in the app and website. Drivers accept cash but do not provide change.

Must I book online?

In addition to the Breeze OnDemand app and website, trips can be booked by phone at 941-300-1553.

Can I book for multiple passengers?

Rides can be booked for up to 3 companion passengers.

What if I’m traveling with a mobility device or bicycle?

During the booking process, passengers may request a van with wheelchair accessibility or with a bike rack.

Is there a minimum age to ride?

Per the contracted service provider, passengers must be aged 13 or older to ride without a guardian.



OnDemand TD

Passengers participating in the Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) program ride for \$1.50 and can reserve a trip up to 7 days in advance. Learn about the TD program on the next page!

Eligibility-based programs

Breeze Plus riders must be approved through an application process.

The application is available on the scgov.net/breeze webpage. For assistance with applications call **941-861-1018**.

Reservations are accepted as early as 14 days in advance of a trip, and must be made no later than 5 p.m. the day prior to a trip.

Other passengers traveling a similar route may be picked up or dropped off during each trip.

ADA Program

Clients whose disability prevents from using Breeze routes, may apply for the ADA Program.

Eligible disabilities include those that:

- Prevent a rider from independently navigating Breeze routes or
- Require an accessible vehicle not available on Breeze routes or
- Prevent the passenger from reaching the Breeze transit stop.

Passengers may be granted temporary, conditional, or unconditional approval.

The ADA Program is offered within 3/4 mile of each Breeze route.

Service hours align with each associated Breeze route.

TD Program

Clients who are unable to transport themselves and who do not have the funds or financial assistance to purchase transportation (including through Breeze routes), are eligible for the Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) Program if they also have:

- An ADA-qualifying disability or
- An age of 65+ years or
- A household income at 150% or less of the federal poverty level.

Trips will be prioritized for these purposes and in this order: critical care, other medical purpose, employment, education, and other purpose.

The TD service area includes all of Sarasota County. Service hours are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturday (medical trips only) 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

ADA and TD trip reservations can be made at 941-777-6000.

Veterans Medical Transportation Program

This program is for trips from Sarasota County to the Bay Pines VA Healthcare System in Bay Pines or to James A. Haley Veterans' Hospital in Tampa.

Clients must be registered as a veteran through Breeze Plus. Call the Mobility Coordinator at 941-861-1018 to register. Medical appointments should be scheduled between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. at Bay Pines or between 10:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. at James A. Haley. Passengers can be picked up and dropped off at any of 6 Sarasota County locations. Roundtrip fare ranges from \$8 to \$13 depending on the pickup/dropoff location.

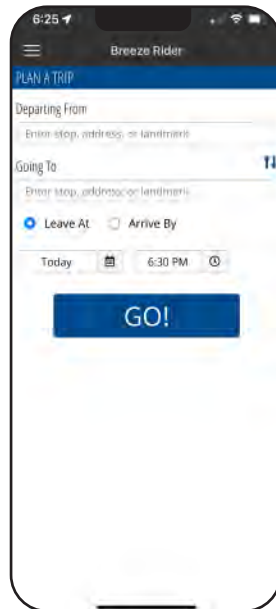

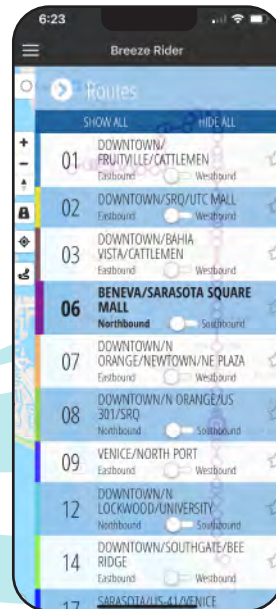

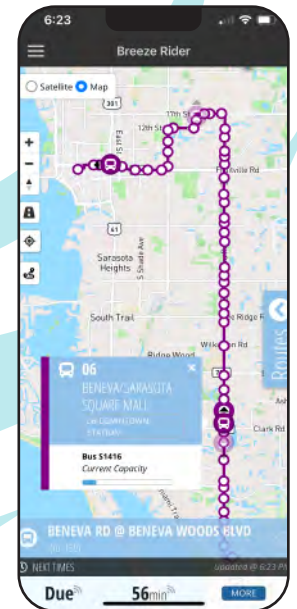

Frequently Asked Questions

Does Breeze accept credit cards?

Fare can be paid with cash, a single-ride ticket, or a 30-day pass.
Overpayments are credited on a voucher.

Are buses ADA-accessible?

Every bus can both “kneel” at the curb and deploy a boarding ramp, and is equipped with two spaces for passengers in wheelchairs.

Can I bring my bike on the bus?

Buses are equipped with exterior racks that can accommodate up to 2 bicycles.

How will the driver know to let me off the bus?

The bus will only pull over at designated stops.
Pull the yellow cable when approaching your stop.

Does my fare include transfers?

Passengers are required to pay fare each time they board a Breeze vehicle.



Touring Routes

76 Flyer Trolley between SRQ Airport and hotels in downtown Sarasota; equipped with a luggage rack. Fare is \$2.

77 Siesta Islander Trolley connecting downtown Sarasota to attractions on Siesta Key. Everyone rides free.

78 Bay Runner Trolley connecting downtown Sarasota to St Armands Circle and Lido Key. Everyone rides free.
