Project Description

The agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. (Kimley-Horn) will provide for design and permitting for the widening of the existing 2-lane section of Honore Avenue from the Fruitville Road intersection north to 17th Street to a 4-lane urban arterial section with closed drainage, a distance of approximately 1.0 miles in length. The project includes the addition of two through travel lanes, bicycle lanes, sidewalks on both sides of Honore Avenue, roadway lighting and landscaping. The existing one lane roundabout at Honore Avenue and Richardson Road will be widened to a 2-lane roundabout and the signalized intersection at Honore Avenue and 17th Street will be converted to a 2-lane roundabout. Stormwater facilities and drainage to accommodate the roadway improvements are also included in the design. Community engagement will be implemented near the 30% design progress level, and at substantial completion prior to construction.

Project Progress/Status

The Consultant provided 100% complete design plans for County review. Environmental review and mitigation site investigation is in progress. Voluntary right-of-way acquisition is progressing. The design is planned to be completed in early summer 2026.
