Project Description

Wellfield Park is an existing recreational facility in the City of Venice, situated on a parcel of approximately 80 acres. The park currently features a variety of amenities, including baseball, softball, football, and soccer fields, as well as croquet, disc golf, basketball, and tennis/pickleball courts. The Wellfield Regional Park Improvements Project will begin with the development of a comprehensive master plan for the City of Venice's park network. This plan will include Wellfield Park, Foxworthy Park, and Pinebrook Park. While the primary focus will be on the redevelopment of Wellfield Park, potential impacts to Foxworthy and Pinebrook Parks warrant their inclusion in this initial planning phase. The overall goal of the project is to redevelop and expand the number of athletic fields at Wellfield Regional Park, improve circulation to create a more community-friendly environment, and incorporate additional amenities such as restrooms, concession areas, shade structures, meeting spaces, and a new maintenance facility. All while keeping the existing leagues play operational throughout the re-development.

Project Progress/Status

Environmental assessments, existing infrastructure review, and survey are ongoing. Technical memorandums to be issued in early June. Three (3) initial Master Plan options are being further developed for County review in late May. Based on these options, construction sequencing will be presented in June, to eventually refine a single concept for development. Stakeholder meetings with Football, Soccer, Softball, Croquet, Baseball, Lacrosse, and Friends of Pinebrook are were held between May 18th - May 29th, to gather community input.
